## Special Rules

### **Light Gun Battery - p.36**

Light Gun Batteries may not be deployed in Ambush.

### **Light Howitzer Battery - p.37**

Light Howitzer Batteries may not be deployed in Ambush.

### **Piechoty Company - p.33**

Piechoty and Machine-gun Platoons from a Piechoty Company operate as separate platoons, each with their own command team. Although its platoons operate separately for all other purposes, a Piechoty Company deploys all at the same time as a single platoon. For example, this means that you treat the entire Piechoty Company as a single platoon when calculating the number of platoons held in Ambush or Reserve.

### **Piechoty Scout Platoon - p.35**

Not Lancers

Mounted infantry scout platoons are mounted infantrymen rather than cavalymen and are not trained in the use of lances. Cavalry teams in a Piechoty Scout Platoon do not use the Lancers special rule on page 50.

### **Piechoty Scout Platoon - p.35**

Piechoty Scout Platoons are Reconnaissance Platoons.

### **Reconnaissance Tank Platoon - p.29**

An armoured battalion was attached to each cavalry brigade at the start of the war. Reconnaissance Tank Platoons are rated as Fearless Trained.
