Special Rules

Air Support - p.152

The Hurricane II is a dedicated air superiority fighter. It can only be used for Fighter Interception and cannot be used for Ground Attack.

Commonwealth Rifle Platoon (NZ) - p.139

Haka (Maori only)

Enemy platoons must reroll their first successful Motivation Test to Counterattack a Maori platoon that Launched an Assault against them.

A Maori platoon must make a Breakthrough Assault if it is able to.

Divisional Cavalry Carrier Platoon (NZ) - p.132

Carrier Platoons are Reconnaissance Platoons.

Divisional Cavalry Platoon (NZ) - p.132

New Zealand Divisional Cavalry Platoons in your force must have the same type of vehicle as your Company Command vehicle.

Divisional Cavalry Squadron HQ (NZ) - p.131

A Divisional Cavalry Squadron that is the attacker in a mission with the Defensive Battle special rule may move any one objective on the opponent's side of the table immediately after deployment before Reconnaissance Deployment moves. It may be placed up to 12"/30cm from its original position, but may only be placed inside the objective's original deployment area as defined by the mission, obeying any other mission rules.

Divisional Cavalry Squadron HQ (NZ) - p.131

Universal Carriers in a Divisional Cavalry Squadron HQ are Recce teams.

Divisional Cavalry Stuart Platoon (NZ) - p.133

A New Zealand Divisional Cavalry Squadron may not field a Divisional Cavalry Stuart Platoon if it contains any Marmon-Herrington II armoured cars.

Field Battery, Royal Artillery (NZ) - p.150

Although a Field Battery, Royal Artillery is a single Support choice, each Gun Troop operates as a separate platoon with its own Command team. The Staff team is an Independent team.

Field Battery, Royal Artillery (NZ) - p.150

Although they count as separate platoons for all other purposes, a Field Battery, Royal Artillery deploys as a single platoon, all at the same time. For example, all three Gun Troops are treated as a single platoon when calculating the number of platoons held in Reserve.

Field Battery, Royal Artillery (NZ) - p.150

Field Batteries, Royal Artillery may not be deployed in Ambush.

Field Battery, Royal Artillery (NZ) - p.150

Note: The third Gun Troop does not have an Observer team. If the battery has OQF 4.5" howitzers, they will be from this troop and do not have an Observer team.

Portee Anti-tank Platoon, Royal Artillery (NZ) - p.148

The OQF 18 pdr guns of a Portee Anti-tank Platoon, Royal Artillery cannot fire Artillery Bombardments.
