### **Heavy Cruiser Armoured Company - p.114**

The HQ and Armoured Platoons of Heavy Cruiser Armoured Companies, Light Cruiser Armoured Companies, Light Armoured Companies and Captured Armoured Companies operate as separate platoons, each with their own Platoon Command team. The HQ Platoon is a headquarters in name only. It operates the same as any other platoon led by a normal Platoon Command team.
